

Thanks for purchasing the Greyhound Dutch Traps

If you have subscribed to Horse Dutch Bot /Lay Horse bot/ Auto profit Soccer/ APS Deluxe/ SAW Deluxe/ Magic Soccer Bot/Lay Greyhound bot in past, then you can go through this manual very quickly.

Let's start the deep dive into the Greyhound Dutch Traps

Once you open the bot, complete the registration process and click on desktop icon, then you will see the below screen, where you have to input your betfair id and password and click on login.

Please enter your betfair Username , Password and Select your Domain (default would work for most) and press the "Login" Button

OR

Select only the Domain and press the "Interactive Login" Button

*you would have got latest version from the download page.

If you are betting on Betfair.com ,then login using your id and password in this screen.

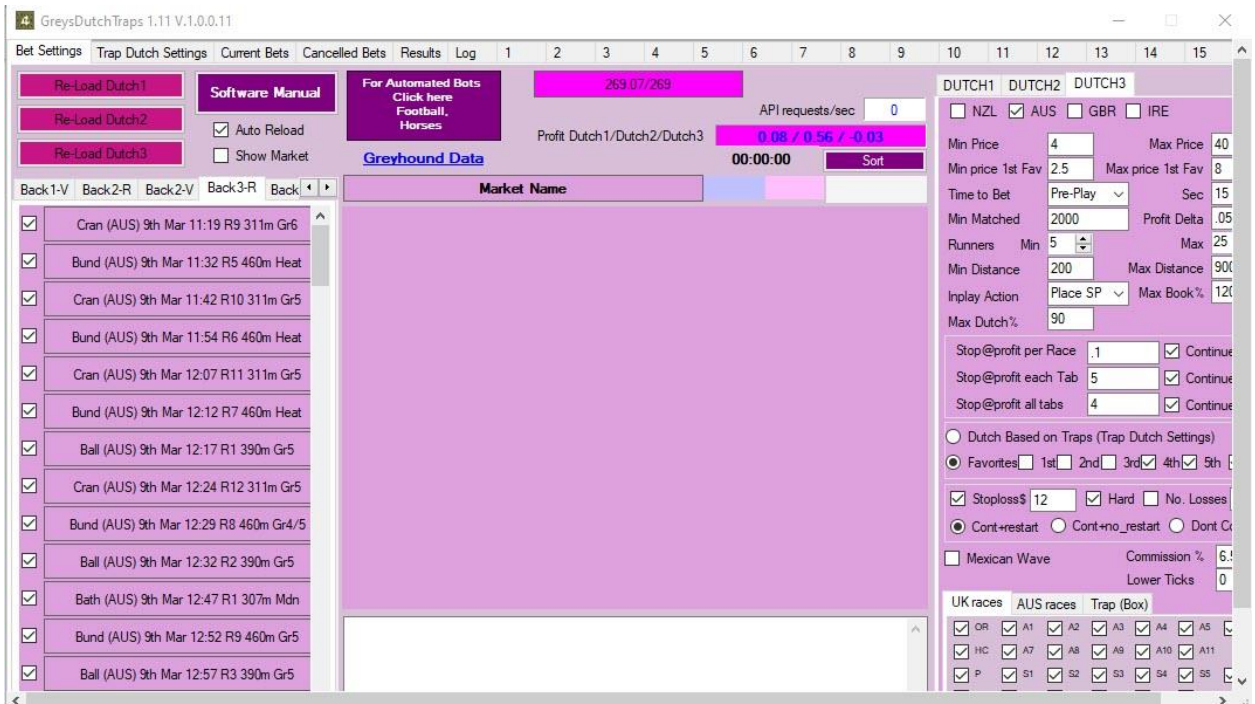
Procedure for Romanian and Italian clients -If you have access to ONLY Betfair.ro (Romania) and betfair.it (Italy), then use the respective interactive buttons. When you click on interactive, a new window will open (See screen below), input your login ids in that screen and submit.



Please press submit and above screen will close and then simply press login on the main screen.

No Need to input betfair id again on this screen for Romanian and Italian clients. Simply click on Login.

Post login, You will see the following screen.

As you can see, you can run up to three different dutching strategies with Greyhound Dutch Traps Bot. You can select countries you want to bet for each laying strategy.

For example : *Dutch 1*– you can bet only on Australia and NZ, *Dutch 2* – you can only bet on UK & Ireland etc.

Min Distance and Max Distance is the race distance which user can select for the races he wants to bet on.

Min Distance Max Distance

Min price and Max price is the price range which user can select for the dog to be qualified for betting

Min Price Max Price

Min 1st Fav price and Max 1st Fav price is the price range which user can select if he is betting on a dog apart from the 1st favorite. If he is betting on 1st Favorite, these two boxes will be greyed out.

Min price 1st Fav Max price 1st Fav

Time to bet:

Time to Bet Sec

Select Pre-Play and 25 seconds in **Time to bet** settings. So, all races to be checked for qualification starting 25 seconds before the official start of the match.

Min Matched Profit Delta

Minimum amount matched: Amount of minimum money should be matched in the race for bot to make a qualified selection. In order to avoid low liquidity races, atleast keep \$2000 or more as per your equalivant currency.

Profit Delta

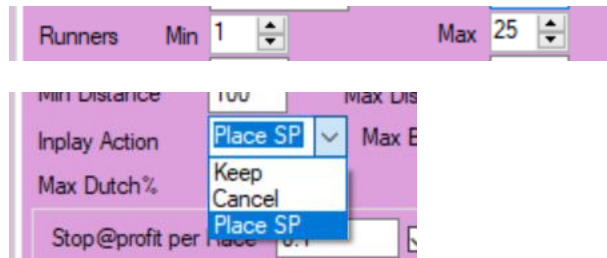
Profit Delta – This is another great feature in the bot. Profit delta is the amount by which next lay stake will be increased once you have the losing bet. For example, if

your stop@profit per match is \$1 and you have profit delta as \$.5, then if you have first match as a losing bet, then your 2nd target will not be \$1 but it will be \$1.5.

Plus what additional stake you may have because of the losses in other tabs, as that loss will be distributed to other tabs based on the option you have selected.

Max Book % - Over round for the entire race before the off should not be more than 103.

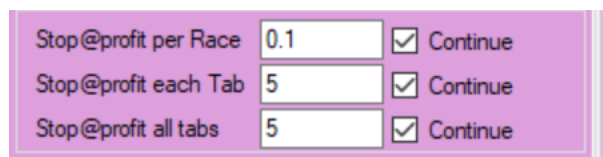
Runners – Min and Max runners you want for race to be qualified.



You can select if you want to keep bets during In play as keep, cancel or Place SP. Place SP is recommended.



Max Dutch % This is the limit as high as the bot will allow, over 90% in this example, the bot would not make the bet, to bet this high you would need an odds on selection (we recommend no lower than 2.0)



Above settings are very important to understand. I have not spoken about tabs yet, which I will cover later.

Stop@profit per race is the amount which you want to make from each winning race.

Stop@profit each tab is the amount of profit which you want to make from each tab

Stop@profit all tabs is the overall amount of profit which you want to make from the bot overall.

Last column is **back up trap** – you need to input trap manually here for UK and Ireland if one of your trap dogs is not running, back up trap will be used.


For Australia – Trap 9 and Trap 10 are back up dogs anyway so they are auto moved to the vacant traps.

Select Traps (added Version 1.11) You can exclude a track from both Fav and Box/Trap option.

If you untick a track it will not be bet by the bot.

Next is on how to control the stake on each selection:-

Stop Loss @ staking for each tab (staking setting) – is the value once passed then the tab will either stop betting or restart the sequence of the betting.

Cont+ restart. If the stake is under target, it will continue betting recovery losses and targets.

Cont+ no_restart. This button checked will bet regardless of the setting. This is the setting you use when you want option to control the liability. So, if in the staking option it is button is active, then the bot is looking at the liability and not the stake to control what is bet.

Don't cont: If this is ticked, it will bet until the staking has exceeded the limit, and then stop betting that tab.

Hard tick : if Hard is ticked, then the bot will not bet over the stop loss amount but restart the sequence if you also have cont+ restart also ticked.

Please keep in mind, bot will pass the stop loss figure , as it will place a bet, if the loss is below the stop loss , so remember, a 10 stop loss could actually be much higher. Once the stop loss has been passed, it will either stop or restart (if option is ticked)

Example : If stop loss is set at 50, and the tab has a loss of say 48.00, the bot will still try and recover that 48 as it is under 50, so if the odds are say 2.0, then it will bet around 50 to recover the 48 loss plus the target. Meaning you

will be at 98 should the bet lose. That is when the tab would stop trying to recover the loss.

Continue Button

Continue button will ensure that the bot should not stop once profit target is reached (per match or per tab) but it will start the fresh cycle. So, if you want to keep running the bot always, please keep the continue button ticked.

You will see this pop up when making staking changes and also when you start the bot up, this warning is a betfair regulation.

Commission/ Lower Ticks Option. (added version 1.11)

The commission is now available within the individual dutches, where before the commission was for all dutches.

Lower Ticks if a value is in there, it will fire the bet in and ask below the current price, so that you have a great chance to get the bet accepted, rather than having to wait for the SP if the price is dropping. Of course, the bot will take the best price.

EG, if the price is 2.20, and you have 2 ticks entered it will mean the bot will fire the bet in at 2.16 (2p at tick in this odds range), and if 2.20 is available it will be taken, if not then 2.18 or 2.16 if both are gone then it will wait for the SP if you have that option selected.



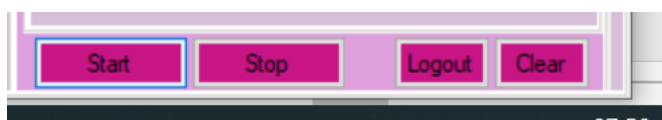
User can select the type of races he wants to bet on. It is only available for UK and Australian dog races.

Please remember **Others** include every type which is not shown in the box.

Trap Box:-



User can select which trap boxes he wants to bet into. We have provided upto ten traps to cover special dog races as well.



Start button: - Once the settings are set by the user, press the start button in order to start the bot.

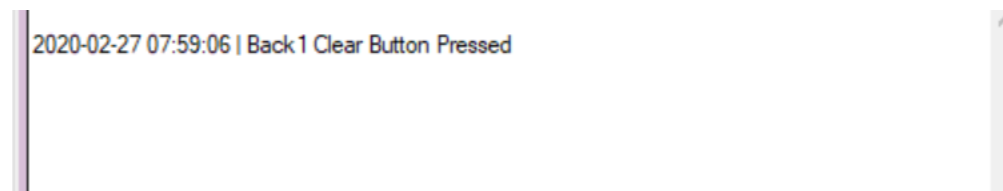
Stop button: - press the stop button to stop the bot.

Log out: - press the log out button and you will come out of the bot.

Clear button

when you start betting next day, the bot will start from the same cycle where you left it previous day unless you use a clear button and want to start fresh. If you want to continue the same cycle, don't use the clear button and just press the start button and let it run every day. There are respective clear buttons for each tab for each lay as well.

There is one box which you will see at the middle center of the interface.



It will show at what time the user pressed the clear button for the particular tab. The profit/loss for tabs will be shown accordingly from the time the clear button was last clicked.

As soon as you press the clear button, the bot will erase all staking sequence , profit/loss etc and will start fresh.



When you click on software manual, you would have got access to this manual only.

API requests/sec – It shows you the number of API Calls per second being requested from betfair. As long as it is below 10, you are within the betfair limit and no data charges will be charged to your account. We have designed all our bots in such a way, that it should remain under 10.

You have the sort button if you want to see the market order. (Need Show Market ticked).

Profit Dutch1/Dutch2/Dutch3, shows the profit and loss of each Dutch.

Auto reload: This button (if checked) will keep on loading the greyhound markets for the day every 2nd hour. If you want to keep the bot running on your desktop/laptop or VPS, please keep it checked.

Please keep auto reload checked all the time.

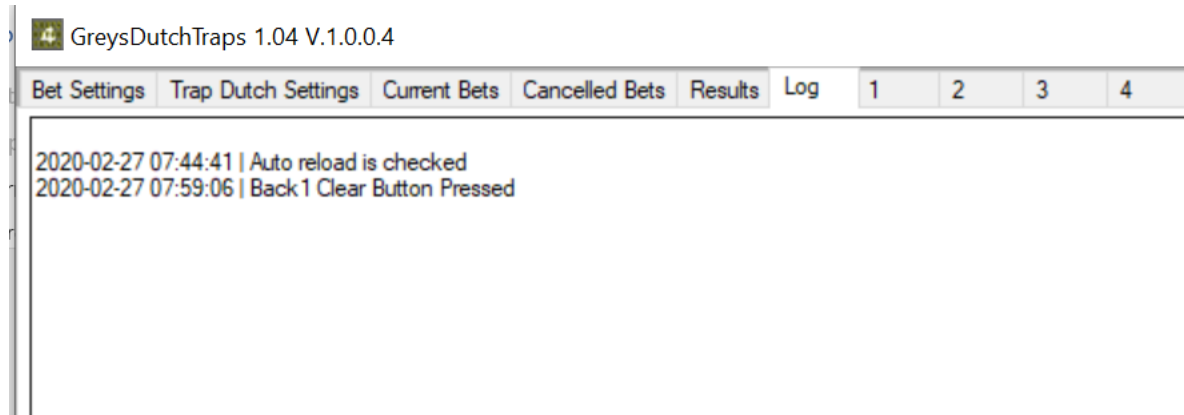
In results tab, you can see all consolidated results for each tab. Cumulative profit is shown at the top.

With the export button, you can download all results in .csv file.

Enable this Tab

Very important to keep the tabs enabled, otherwise bot will not take any bet in that tab, if it is not enabled.

Log tab:-



This is very important feature in all of our bots. Now, the user can see what the bot is doing second by second. You may not be able to understand everything what is in the log but it is helpful in order to investigate any error.

You can access the detailed log file at the following address: -

C:\Program Files (x86)\Profit Sports Betting\Greyhound Dutch Traps\log_files

If you are our existing user of Horse Dutch Bot or APS Deluxe , then I am sure you will find Greyhound Dutch Traps very comfortable to use. But if you are new to our bots, I strongly recommend you go through and read APS manual and the user videos, so you get end to end view on functioning of our bots.
